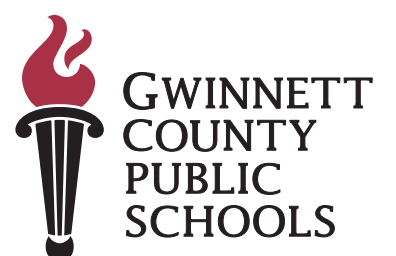
The **Student Survey** is administered **January 19 through February 3** for students in grades 3-12 during the school day and is available in the Student Portal.
