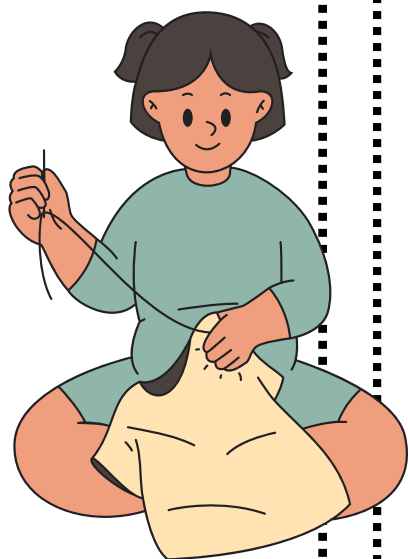
Sewing Club
