Restrictive Application Plans

Early Decision (ED)

Students make a commitment to a first-choice institution where, if admitted they definitely will enroll. The application deadline and decision deadline occur early.

COMMITMENT:

BINDING

Restrictive Early Action (REA)

DEFINITION:

Students apply to an institution of preference and receive a decision early. They may be restricted from applying ED or EA or REA to other institutions. If offered enroliment, they have until May 1 to confirm.

COMMITMENT:

NON-BINDING

Students are responsible for determining and following restrictions.

ACCESSING HOPE GPA

- Preliminary HOPE GPAs are available on <u>GAfutures.</u>
 - Students should create an account now.
 - In order for the student to access their HOPE GPA, they need to have:
 - SSN on file at Brookwood
 - If not, please turn in a copy of the SSN to office A1 Done by the student when they create their account
 - SSN entered into student's account on GAfutures





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

 - \$500-\$5,000 awarded to students of Hispanic descent


