- Google Meet has been added to your apps and is easy and intuitive to use.
- You start a meeting and enter a title. Then click "Join Now" and Google will give you information to share so others may join you.
- You can also use a join code that can be emailed to students.
- You have the option to record a meeting, change the meeting layout, turn on captions, and more.
- Hints
 - Set a time window you are available.
 - Don't leave students unattended in the room.

Planning for instruction - Start with the AKS

Think about instruction first not technology.

- What are you trying to teach?
- How would you plan face-to-face?

 - Collaborate with a colleague or LSTC if you are not sure what to use.

- All GOC lessons are aligned to the AKS.
- The district has auto-enrolled subject teachers in the DLD Resource pages. To access
 these, click the Course Selector waffle in the top right and type "DLD Content 2020" in the
 search box.





 The list of courses with GOC content in which a teacher is enrolled should appear. Click the desired course.





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On the course homepage, scroll down until you see the Content Browser widget. You'll see a list of names, each with a folder icon, which all include additional county resources. GOC content is fairly clearly marked. Click on the folder to start navigating to GOC resources. You may see unit folders nested, but if you keep clicking, you'll reach the content items.
