

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A Mini-lesson LIVE using Google Meet



- Google Meet has been added to your apps and is easy and intuitive to use.
- You start a meeting and enter a title. Then click “Join Now” and Google will give you information to share so others may join you.
- You can also use a join code that can be emailed to students.
- You have the option to record a meeting, change the meeting layout, turn on captions, and more.
- Hints
 - Set a time window you are available.
 - *Don't leave students unattended in the room.*

Digital Learning Day Assessment Tips

The chart below will provide some helpful formative and summative assessment tips to monitor student mastery.

A few things to keep in mind when creating formative assessment opportunities in an online environment:

- Clearly state the student deliverable (is the student submitting an audio file, a Word document, a discussion post, etc.)
- Provide students with a rubric (this will ensure the work is fully completed and streamline the grading process)
- Before publishing, preview the directions and assignment to verify that your message is clear



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General Digital Learning Tips




- Planning for instruction - Start with the AKS
- **Think about instruction first not technology.**
 - What are you trying to teach?
 - How would you plan face-to-face?
 - What is the best instructional strategy would be best practice to teach the skill or concept?
 - What technology do you need to deliver that strategy?
 - Collaborate with a colleague or LSTC if you are not sure what to use.



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GOC Lessons for High School Courses


- GOC has made their lessons available to teachers across the district. You may choose to assign a lesson or a unit to your students.

- The district has auto-enrolled subject teachers in the DLD Resource pages. To access these, click the Course Selector waffle in the top right and type “DLD Content 2020” in the search box.



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GOC Lessons for High School Courses


- The list of courses with GOC content in which a teacher is enrolled should appear. Click the desired course.



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GOC Lessons for High School Courses


- On the course homepage, scroll down until you see the Content Browser widget. You'll see a list of names, each with a folder icon, which all include additional county resources. GOC content is fairly clearly marked. Click on the folder to start navigating to GOC resources. You may see unit folders nested, but if you keep clicking, you'll reach the content items.
