- Naming Conventions Are Essential





  - especially with parents



# Parent Help - How much is too much? Ms. Austin

- View parents as partners in the process.
- Think about what students should be able to do on their own make sure it is age appropriate.
- Give clear, limited-step directions.
- Over time, students should become more independent.
- Be clear about what students should complete on their own.
- Be flexible and understanding as families navigate the technology.





## General Digital Learning Tips Dr. Griffin

- Use web tools your students already know how to use
  - Introduce new tools slowly one new every few weeks
  - Check the approved vendor list and follow the guidelines for use of specific tools








## Video Note in eCLASS Dr. Griffin




- GOC has made their lessons available to teachers across the district.

## GOC Lessons for Middle School Courses Mr. Wise


On the course homepage, scroll down until you see the Content Browser widget. You'll see
