

Gwinnett County Public Schools Homeless Education Program

HOMELESS CHILDREN AND YOUTH HAVE THE RIGHT TO A FREE and APPROPRIATE PUBLIC EDUCATION

If you and your child:

- Live in a shelter or motel,
- Share housing with relatives or others because you lost your housing or cannot afford housing,
- Live in a campground, car, abandoned building, or other inadequate shelter,
- Do not have a permanent address and/or permanent housing, or
- Live on the street,

Your child has the right to:

- Immediately enroll in and attend school without having health and school records available,
- Enroll in the school serving the address where you are living temporarily or in the school most recently attended, whichever is feasible and in your child's best interest,
- Receive transportation to and from school when feasible,
- Participate in school-related activities and receive other services, including free school meals, and
- Utilize the dispute resolution process if you have a grievance.
