Accountability and flexibility are hallmarks of Gwinnett County Public Schools' success. Key to that success is ensuring that each school community understands the progress being made by its schools, as well as what plans will drive improvement. Each school creates a collaborative Local School Plan for Improvement (LSPI), with targeted goals based on student achievement results. These goals are dynamic, like our schools, and are updated to reflect changes that occur in schools. Data is used to determine areas needing improvement and to identify specific, measurable, annual objectives. Schools then determine how to use research-based strategies to achieve these goals, using flexibility as needed. The LSPI development process involves teachers, parents, and community members, so the entire school community has the opportunity to be involved in conversations about school improvement. - **Long Term Goal**

Archer High School students will acquire the knowledge and skills to be successful as they continue their education at the postsecondary level and/or enter the workforce.

- o **Annual Goal**

Archer High School's CCRPI score will be in the top 25% of Georgia high schools in 2021-22.

- o **Annual Goal**

Graduation Goal: The 2022 cohort graduation rate for Archer students will increase to 93%.

- o **Annual Goal**

Career and Technical Education Goal: The percentage of Archer students enrolled in a CTE Pathway at Maxwell, Grayson Tech, or the local school will be greater than the 2020-2021 value. Archer will increase the number of EOPA's administered and the percentage of EOPA's passed in 2022. Student participation in select courses associated with the AgSTEM program (agricultural science, environmental science, engineering, scientific research I & II), will increase over the previous year.

- o **Annual Goal**

End of Course Test Goal: Student performance in 2022 will increase on EOC's for US History, Biology, Algebra I, and 11th grade Language Arts, exceeding the mean scale scores for the top 50% of test takers at Archer in 2021. The 'distinguished' performance in 2022 will exceed the 'distinguished' mean scores among all GCPS high schools 2022.
