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Accountability and flexibility are hallmarks of Gwinnett County Public Schools' success. Key to that success is ensuring that each school community understands the progress being made by its schools, as well as what plans will drive improvement. Each school creates a collaborative Local School Plan for Improvement (LSPI), with targeted goals based on student achievement results. These goals are dynamic, like our schools, and are updated to reflect changes that occur in schools. Data is used to determine areas needing improvement and to identify specific, measurable, annual objectives. Schools then determine how to use research-based strategies to achieve these goals, using flexibility as needed. The LSPI development process involves teachers, parents, and community members, so the entire school community has the opportunity to be involved in conversations about school improvement. - **Long Term Goal**

Brookwood Elementary will increase academic performance in Language Arts to an acceptable goal of 80% and an excellence goal of 90% in grade levels 3, 4 and 5 on the Georgia Milestones by 2025.

- o **Annual Goal**

Brookwood Elementary will increase the percentage of students achieving at the Proficient and Distinguished level in Language Arts on the Georgia Milestones Assessment by 3 percentage points over 2020-2021 results in grade levels 3, 4, and 5 which is acceptable progress. Excellent progress would be to increase the percentage of students scoring in the Proficient and Distinguished levels in each grade level by 6 percentage points over 2020-2021 results.

- **Long Term Goal**

Brookwood Elementary will increase academic performance in Mathematics to an acceptable goal of 80% and an excellence goal of 90% in grade levels 3, 4 and 5 on the Georgia Milestones by 2025.

- o **Annual Goal**

Brookwood Elementary will increase the percentage of students achieving at the Proficient and Distinguished level in Mathematics on the Georgia Milestones Assessment by 3 percentage points over 2020-2021 results in grade levels 3, 4, and 5 which is acceptable progress. Excellent progress would be to increase the percentage of students scoring in the Proficient and Distinguished levels in each grade level by 6 percentage points over 2020-2021 results.

- **Long Term Goal**

The Brookwood Cluster will increase rigor for all students to reach their greatest potential through appropriate acceleration and integration in Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts, and Math.

- o **Annual Goal**

Brookwood Elementary will increase the percentage of fifth grade students achieving at the Proficient and Distinguished level in Science on the Georgia Milestones Assessment by 3 percentage points over 2020-2021 results in grade levels 3, 4, and 5 which is acceptable progress. Excellent progress would be to increase the percentage of students scoring in the Proficient and Distinguished levels in each grade level by 6 percentage points over 2020-2021 results.

- **Long Term Goal**

The Teacher and Student Relationships theme category will increase throughout the school year on the Student Engagement Survey given to 3rd through 5th graders to indicate that positive, supportive relationships are developed throughout the year in classrooms.
