Local School Plan for Improvement Duluth Middle School

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Accountability and flexibility are hallmarks of Gwinnett County Public Schools' success. Key to that success is ensuring that each school community understands the progress being made by its schools, as well as what plans will drive improvement. Each school creates a collaborative Local School Plan for Improvement (LSPI), with targeted goals based on student achievement results. These goals are dynamic, like our schools, and are updated to reflect changes that occur in schools. Data is used to determine areas needing improvement and to identify specific, measurable, annual objectives. Schools then determine how to use research-based strategies to achieve these goals, using flexibility as needed. The LSPI development process involves teachers, parents, and community members, so the entire school community has the opportunity to be involved in conversations about school improvement. Long Term Goal

80% of the students at Duluth Middle School will perform at the Proficient/Distinguished levels on all subjects of the Georgia Milestones assessment.

o Annual Goal

Duluth Middle School will increase the percentage of students scoring in the Proficient and Distinguished performance levels on the EOG/EOC Mathematics Milestones and District Assessments to 56%.

o Annual Goal

90% of Duluth Middle School Students will earn an 80% or higher in their Connections classes both semesters.

o Annual Goal

Duluth Middle School will increase the percentage of students scoring in the Proficient and Distinguished performance levels on the EOG Language Arts Milestones and District Assessments to 54%.

o Annual Goal

Duluth Middle School will increase the percentage of students scoring in the Proficient and Distinguished performance levels on the EOG/EOC Science Milestones (8th) and District Assessments (6-8) to 51%.
