Accountability and flexibility are hallmarks of Gwinnett County Public Schools' success. Key to that success is ensuring that each school community understands the progress being made by its schools, as well as what plans will drive improvement. Each school creates a collaborative Local School Plan for Improvement (LSPI), with targeted goals based on student achievement results. These goals are dynamic, like our schools, and are updated to reflect changes that occur in schools. Data is used to determine areas needing improvement and to identify specific, measurable, annual objectives. Schools then determine how to use research-based strategies to achieve these goals, using flexibility as needed. The LSPI development process involves teachers, parents, and community members, so the entire school community has the opportunity to be involved in conversations about school improvement. Knight Elementary will have 75% or more of students as proficient or distinguished learners in English Language Arts on the Georgia Milestones Assessment System by Spring 2026.

In addition, at least 80% of Knight Elementary students in grades K-5 will perform at or above grade level expectations on the Fountas and Pinnell Reading Assessment.

At least 58% of Knight Elementary School students in grades 3, 4, and 5 will score at proficient or distinguished on the Georgia Milestones Assessment System in English Language Arts, with at least 20% of the students performing at the distinguished level. 57% or more students in 3rd grade will score at proficient or distinguished. 59% or more students in 4th grade will score at proficient or distinguished. 60% or more students in 5th grade will score at proficient or distinguished.

In addition, at least 80% of Knight Elementary students in grades K-5 will perform at or above grade level expectations on the Fountas and Pinnell Reading Assessment.
