

2021 - 2022 Local School Plan for Improvement Meadowcreek High School

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Accountability and flexibility are hallmarks of Gwinnett County Public Schools' success. Key to that success is ensuring that each school community understands the progress being made by its schools, as well as what plans will drive improvement. Each school creates a collaborative Local School Plan for Improvement (LSPI), with targeted goals based on student achievement results. These goals are dynamic, like our schools, and are updated to reflect changes that occur in schools. Data is used to determine areas needing improvement and to identify specific, measurable, annual objectives. Schools then determine how to use research-based strategies to achieve these goals, using flexibility as needed. The LSPI development process involves teachers, parents, and community members, so the entire school community has the opportunity to be involved in conversations about school improvement. • Long Term Goal

All students attending Meadowcreek High School will graduate from high school within four years and one summer.

o Annual Goal

Students will graduate from Meadowcreek High School's college and career ready. The cohort graduation rate will increase by 3% from the final reported 20-21 cohort graduation rate. The number of students taking AP and Dual Enrollment courses will increase. The percentage of students scoring 3 or above on AP exams will increase by 5%. The gains will be across all sub groups.

o Annual Goal

Meadowcreek High School will increase the percentage of students completing pathways by 5%. The number of students completing end of pathway assessments will increase and the percentage of students passing end of pathway assessments will increase.

• Long Term Goal

Students leaving Meadowcreek High School will use effective written and oral communication skills to define, describe, and solve complex problems. Meadowcreek High School students will score at or above the GCPS average on the Science and Social Studies Gateway exams

Long Term Goal

Meadowcreek High School students will effectively use mathematics skills and collaboration to solve novel problems and improve performance on multiple assessments. Meadowcreek High School students will score at or above the GCPS average on the Math and Science Georgia Milestone Assessments.

o Annual Goal

Meadowcreek High School will increase all students' academic performance and mastery as measured by course success rates, End of Course Exams for Algebra I, Biology, U.S. History and 11th Grade Language Arts, Gateway assessments, SAT EBRW and Math, PSAT, and ACT Assessments. Students scores will improve by 5%. The increase will be across all sub groups.

Long Term Goal

We will build our parents' capacity to support their children's academic achievement by implementing the activities identified in The Plan/The Promise.
