Accountability and flexibility are hallmarks of Gwinnett County Public Schools' success. Key to that success is ensuring that each school community understands the progress being made by its schools, as well as what plans will drive improvement. Each school creates a collaborative Local School Plan for Improvement (LSPI), with targeted goals based on student achievement results. These goals are dynamic, like our schools, and are updated to reflect changes that occur in schools. Data is used to determine areas needing improvement and to identify specific, measurable, annual objectives. Schools then determine how to use research-based strategies to achieve these goals, using flexibility as needed. The LSPI development process involves teachers, parents, and community members, so the entire school community has the opportunity to be involved in conversations about school improvement. ### Long Term Goal

Ninety-five percent (95%) of Northbrook Middle School students will perform in the "proficient" or "distinguished" range for the Math, English/L. Arts, Science and Social Studies content area sub tests on the Georgia Milestone Assessment in 2025-2026.

#### o Annual Goal

Northbrook Middle School students in grades 6, 7, and 8 will demonstrate continued improvement in Language Arts during the 2021/22 school year as measured by performing at 5 or more percentage points above the county proficient/distinguished average on Post 1 and Post 2 District Assessments.

#### o Annual Goal

Northbrook Middle School students in grades 6, 7, and 8 will demonstrate continued improvement in Science during the 2021/22 school year as measured by performing at 5 or more percentage points above the county proficient/distinguished average on Post 1 and Post 2 District Assessments.

#### o Annual Goal

Northbrook Middle School students in grades 6, 7, and 8 will demonstrate continued improvement in Social Studies during the 2021/22 school year as measured by performing at 5 or more percentage points above the county proficient/distinguished average on Post 1 and Post 2 District Assessments.

#### o Annual Goal

Northbrook Middle School students in grades 6, 7, and 8 will demonstrate a 90% passing rate in fine arts, world language, physical education/health, or career technical education during the 2021/22 school year.

### o Annual Goal

Ninety-eight percent (98%) of Northbrook gifted students in grades 6, 7, and 8 will perform in the combined Proficient and Distinguished categories on the GCPS Post 1 and Post 2 Assessments in English/Language Arts, Mathematics, Science, and Social Studies.
