Local School Plan for Improvement Peachtree Ridge High School

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Accountability and flexibility are hallmarks of Gwinnett County Public Schools' success. Key to that success is ensuring that each school community understands the progress being made by its schools, as well as what plans will drive improvement. Each school creates a collaborative Local School Plan for Improvement (LSPI), with targeted goals based on student achievement results. These goals are dynamic, like our schools, and are updated to reflect changes that occur in schools. Data is used to determine areas needing improvement and to identify specific, measurable, annual objectives. Schools then determine how to use research-based strategies to achieve these goals, using flexibility as needed. The LSPI development process involves teachers, parents, and community members, so the entire school community has the opportunity to be involved in conversations about school improvement. Long Term Goal

Peachtree Ridge High School will increase its graduation rate to 95% by 2025-26 through a focus on continual improvement in student performance as indicated by Georgia Milestones, Gateway, and AP exams. Particular emphasis will be placed on the ELL/LEP, SWD and economically disadvantaged subgroups in order to meet or exceed local and State accountability targets.

o Annual Goal

Peachtree Ridge High School will increase its cohort graduation rate for all students by 1% through engaging bell to bell instruction for all students, effective culturally responsive teaching practices, continuous effective collaboration, alignment of assessments with the rigor of teaching and learning, integration of acceleration and enrichment opportunities, essential safety nets and Quality Plus Teaching Strategies.

o Annual Goal

Peachtree Ridge High School will maintain its student achievement in Advanced Placement courses while increasing enrollment by 2% and AP test participation by 2% in all subgroups.

Long Term Goal

The Peachtree Ridge cluster will demonstrate improved student literacy and critical thinking. Rigor in the classroom will be increased through an integrated approach involving the alignment of assessments with student learning using vertical teaming, eClass, STEM, and literacy strategies across the curriculum for all students.

o Annual Goal

Peachtree Ridge High School will improve student literacy and critical thinking across all disciplines as measured by an increase in proficiency for each subgroup on local assessments, district assessments, and the overall percentage of students who Meet and/or Exceed the district and state average for each subject area on the Georgia Milestones Assessment.
