

2021 - 2022 Local School Plan for Improvement Summerour Middle School

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Accountability and flexibility are hallmarks of Gwinnett County Public Schools' success. Key to that success is ensuring that each school community understands the progress being made by its schools, as well as what plans will drive improvement. Each school creates a collaborative Local School Plan for Improvement (LSPI), with targeted goals based on student achievement results. These goals are dynamic, like our schools, and are updated to reflect changes that occur in schools. Data is used to determine areas needing improvement and to identify specific, measurable, annual objectives. Schools then determine how to use research-based strategies to achieve these goals, using flexibility as needed. The LSPI development process involves teachers, parents, and community members, so the entire school community has the opportunity to be involved in conversations about school improvement. • Long Term Goal

Summerour Middle School will increase the percentage of students scoring in the "proficient" or "distinguished" range on the Georgia Milestones Assessment for English/Language Arts, Social Studies, Science, and Mathematics to 100% in 2023.

o Annual Goal

Summerour Middle School will increase the level of students scoring proficient by 10% and scoring distinguished by 10% on the Georgia Milestones EOC/EOG assessments for Math, Language Arts, Science and Social Studies.

o Annual Goal

Summerour Middle School students will meet or exceed the district average on district common assessments, including interims and post tests. As a measure of mastery, 70% of students will score proficient or above on all local common assessments, including connections.

o Annual Goal

Summerour Middle School will address student emotional well-being using the Student Engagement Inventory, on which our students will exceed the district average.

o Annual Goal

In order to continually build family/school partnerships for student success, Summerour Middle School will meet or exceed the district average on the Parent Engagement Survey.

o Annual Goal

Summerour Middle School's CCRPI score will be in the top 25% of Georgia middle schools in 2021-2022.

• Long Term Goal

Summerour Middle School students will demonstrate mastery in mathematics and science with 100% of students scoring in the "proficient" or "distinguished" range on the Algebra EOC and Physical Science EOC in 2023.
