This year we will have a judged STEM and Engineering Fair using the Gwinnett County elementary school competition process. The STEM and Engineering Fair is open to K-5 students.

We hope that with your enthusiastic encouragement, your student will participate in the fair by preparing a STEM project based on one of the county's 8 predetermined problems. This opportunity will be an exciting experience for your child. Your child may choose to participate either independently or within a group of 3 or less. Sibling groups are allowed, if all children are students at Walnut Grove.

Students who choose to participate will be required to fulfill ALL parts of the expectations in the STEM Project Guide. STEM and Engineering Fair projects will be judged according to the county rubric. The top project(s) will advance to an IN PERSON Gwinnett Regional Science and Engineering Fair which will be hosted at the Gas South District on February 27, 2025!
