What is PBIS?

Positive Behaviors Interventions and Supports



- Positive behavioral interventions and supports (PBIS) is an approach schools use to promote school safety and good behavior.
- The focus of PBIS is prevention.
 Schools teach kids about behavior expectations and strategies. PBIS recognizes that students can only meet behavior expectations if they know what the expectations are. Everyone learns what's considered appropriate behavior. And they use a common language to talk about it. Throughout the school day in class, at lunch, and on the bus students understand what's expected of them.
- According to <u>research</u>, PBIS leads to better student behavior. In many schools that use PBIS, students get fewer detentions and suspensions. They also earn better grades.


RAMS TICKETS, Ram of the Month
