

GENERAL INFORMATION



WHAT IS DUAL ENROLLMENT?

THE DUAL ENROLLMENT PROGRAM IS AN OPPORTUNITY FOR QUALIFIED HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS TO EARN COLLEGE CREDITS TUITION FREE.

PARTICIPATING STUDENTS ARE ENROLLED IN HIGH SCHOOL AND COLLEGE CONCURRENTLY.

PARTICIPATING STUDENTS CHOOSE TO ENROLL FULL-TIME OR PART-TIME FOR THE FALL, SPRING, AND/OR SUMMER SESSIONS.

THE STUDENT EARNS COLLEGE CREDITS AS WELL AS HIGH SCHOOL CREDITS NEEDED FOR GRADUATION.

WHERE CAN I ATTEND?


A STUDENT MAY APPLY TO ATTEND ANY **PARTICIPATING** PUBLIC COLLEGE, PRIVATE COLLEGE, OR TECHNICAL COLLEGE IN GEORGIA.





WHAT ABOUT TRANSFER CREDIT?

- IT IS THE STUDENT'S RESPONSIBILITY TO TALK WITH COLLEGES REGARDING THEIR POLICIES ON ACCEPTING TRANSFER CREDIT.
- COLLEGES GRANTING TRANSFER
 CREDIT WILL REQUIRE A TRANSCRIPT
 FROM THE DUAL ENROLLMENT
 COLLEGE



HOW DOES GRADING WORK?

✓ IF COLLEGES PROVIDE THE HIGH SCHOOL WITH LETTER GRADES, THE HIGH SCHOOL WILL TRANSCRIBE THE LETTER GRADE TO THE MIDPOINT OF THE GRADING SCALE.

A = 95 B = 85 C = 77

D = 72 **F** = 55

✓ NO ADDITIONAL POINTS ARE ADDED TO THE DUAL ENROLLMENT FINAL GRADE- LIKE THE ADDITIONAL 10 POINTS FOR AP CLASSES



• PART-TIME DUAL ENROLLMENT (COMBINATION OF 6 CLASSES BETWEEN THE COLLEGE AND HIGH SCHOOL)

• FULL-TIME DUAL ENROLLMENT (AT LEAST 4 COURSES AT THE COLLEGE)

- DOUBLE CREDIT ON MOST COURSES

<u>CONS</u>

- STUDENTS MUST KEEP UP WITH IMPORTANT JUNIOR/SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL INFORMATION.
- TRANSPORTATION
- ATTENDANCE
- COLLEGES WILL NOT
 COMMUNICATE WITH
 PARENTS OR COUNSELORS
 ABOUT DUAL ENROLLMENT
 STUDENTS.

BE AWARE!!!

A STUDENT MUST MEET THE ENTRANCE REQUIREMENTS OF THE COLLEGE.

- IT IS THE STUDENT'S RESPONSIBILITY TO REGISTER FOR THE CORRECT CLASSES AS ADVISED BY THEIR COUNSELOR (HIGH AND COLLEGE ADVISOR)
- ✓ THE STUDENT IS RESPONSIBLE FOR ALL INTERACTION WITH THE COLLEGE. THE COLLEGE WILL NOT SPEAK WITH A PARENT OR THE DE COORDINATOR REGARDING THE STUDENT.
- ✓ STUDENTS MUST HAVE ALL SCHEDULE CHANGES APPROVED BY THEIR COUNSELOR.
- ✓ HOLIDAYS SUCH AS SPRING BREAK MAY BE DIFFERENT FROM THE GWINNETT COUNTY HOLIDAYS.
- ✓ STUDENTS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY LAB FEES OR FEES ASSOCIATED WITH LATE REGISTRATION
- ✓ DUAL ENROLLMENT COURSES BEGIN A STUDENT'S OFFICIAL COLLEGE TRANSCRIPT AND GPA
- ✓ DUAL ENROLLMENT WILL PAY FOR 30 CREDIT HOURS ONLY! ANY ADDITIONAL CREDIT HOURS IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE STUDENT.





WHO QUALIFIES FOR DUAL ENROLLMENT AT GGC

DUAL ENROLLMENT ADMISSION CRITERIA FOR SPRING 2024, SUMMER 2024, AND FALL 2024

•BY THE FIRST DAY OF SEMESTER AT GGC:

- MUST BE 16 YEARS OF AGE
- MUST BE AN 11TH OR 12TH GRADE STUDENT

•BE ON-TRACK FOR COMPLETING ALL HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

•BE ON-TRACK FOR COMPLETING THE USG'S REQUIRED HIGH SCHOOL CURRICULUM (RHSC)

•HAVE A 3.25 HIGH SCHOOL GPA AS CALCULATED BY GGC ADMISSIONS ON THE RHSC COURSES COMPLETED

•MEET GSFC'S DUAL ENROLLMENT FUNDING PROGRAM ELIGIBILITY (DETAILS ON GAFUTURES SITE: GAFUTURES.ORG)

WHO QUALIFIES FOR DUAL ENROLLMENT AT GGC

TEST SCORES (NOT REQUIRED FOR ADMISSION TO DE BUT CAN BE SUBMITTED)

TEST SCORES

- ENGLISH
 - SAT EVIDENCE BASED READING AND WRITING: 500
 - ACT ENGLISH OR READING: 21
 - ACCUPLACER WRITEPLACER: 4 AND READING COMPREHENSION: 237
 - OR
- MATH
 - SAT MATH: 510
 - ACT MATH: 20
 - ACCUPLACER QUANTITATIVE REASONING, ALGEBRA, AND STATISTICS: 266

STUDENTS WHO DO NOT ATTEND A REGIONALLY ACCREDITED HIGH SCHOOL OR HOME SCHOOL PROGRAM ARE REQUIRED TO SUBMIT A HOME SCHOOL PORTFOLIO.

HOW DO I APPLY?

- 1. CREATE GRIZZLY PROFILE TO APPLY ONLINE, DUAL ENROLLMENT STUDENTS ARE EXEMPTED FROM APPLICATION FEE- WATCH FOR A POP-UP IN YOUR BROWSER WINDOW
- 2. REVIEW ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS
- 3. SUBMIT DOCUMENT REQUIREMENTS
- 4. MEET WITH YOUR HIGH SCHOOL COUNSELOR SO THEY CAN BEGIN THE APPROVAL PROCESS ON THE HIGH SCHOOL SIDE.

✓ Eligibility:

- 10th grade can take <u>technical (CTAE) courses</u> (2.0 GPA or *test scores*)
- 11th-12th grade can take <u>general education and</u> <u>technical courses</u> (2.6 GPA or test scores)
- 28 general education courses guaranteed to transfer to any USG college or university
- Participate in Fall, Spring, and Summer semesters
- Classes offered online or on campus
- Over 140 different programs of study

Dual Enrollment Funding

- ✓ 10th graders can only utilize funding for CTAE classes
 - A minimum SAT score of 1200 or minimum ACT composite score of 26 in a single national test administration for core classes
- ✓ 11th and 12th graders can utilize funding for core classes and/or CTAE classes
- ✓ up to 30 College Credit Hours of Dual Enrollment Funding (Approved list under the course directory in <u>GAFutures.org</u>)
- ✓ 100% of Tuition, Regular Fees, and Textbooks
 - Lab fees and other program-specific fees are not covered by Dual Enrollment Funding.
