Secure Passwords Tip Sheet

Unsafe passwords

- Email address or log-in
- Personal details (name, address, phone #, birthday, etc.)
- A dictionary word (in ANY language)

Safe passwords

- 8 characters long
- Combination of
 - Small letters
 - Capital letters
 - Numbers
 - Special Characters

Tips for creating safe <u>and</u> easy to remember passwords

Tip #1 - replace a letter with a number

• Ex. – raiders → raiders or raid3rs

Tip #2 - Replace A letter with a Special Character

• Ex. – raiders \rightarrow r@!ders

Tip #3 – use capital letters in a random place

• Ex. – raiders → raiDers

Tip #4 – use the 1st letter of ea. Word in a sentence and replace some words/letters with symbols

- Ex. In April, I will start my first job → iAiw\$m1j
- Ex. My little sister weighed 7 pounds at birth → Mlsw7#@b

Keep your password safe & secure

- **Never** write your passwords down
- Don't share your password with anyone
- Change your password regularly (use new password each school year)
