- How much experience have you had in working with children or adolescents who have emotional or behavior problems?
- What general approach to treatment do you use? What methods are used?
- Do you try to include the family in some of the sessions?
- Will my child be tested? If so, what are the costs?
- What is the cost of each session? Does insurance cover the cost?
- What are your hours of operation? What is your policy on cancelled appointments?
- Are you working under the supervision of a psychiatrist?
