

What Do the School Counselors at Level Creek Do?

Guidance Curriculum

Classroom guidance lessons for every class

Small groups

School wide programs such as Student Leadership

Responsive Services

Meet with individual students

Meet with groups of students to address immediate concerns

Assist and provide support in times of crisis

Help refer families to receive needed help- (therapists, church groups and other organizations that offer holiday and food help)

Consult with outside agencies

Refer to outside agencies such as DFACS and KidsNet when needed

Weekly meetings with school social worker

Consult with parents

Monitor & work to improve student attendance

Provide support & feedback during Student Support Team meetings

Head several school programs such as

- BTL Council (Be the Leader) for 5th grade

- C.O.P.S. mentoring program (a collaboration with the Suwanee Police)

- Care Team to help students with financial needs

- Homeless Administrator

Individual Student Planning

Preventative individual counseling (goal setting, etc.)

Consult with staff and administration to determine how to best meet needs of a student

Consult with parents to determine how to best meet needs of their child

Continuous learning through professional development/county meetings/counselor conferences.
