- If you are in need of food you will need to bring: (1) a government issued photo id, (2) a current utility bill verifying your residential address [your address is not a criteria for getting food but for our information regarding the amount of food we donate to that address], (3) a current pay stub (or other income verification document), and (4) verification of family members living in your home.

- On the second Saturday of every month, StreetWise Georgia takes part in an initiative to feed more families in America, originally designed by the Atlanta Community Food Bank. They receive an additional shipment of food from the food bank and it is then divided into individual bags, put onto pallets in our parking lot, and distributed to needy families from all across our community. Registered guests never have to get out of their vehicles. Photo ID is required at check in. Guests drive through the parking lot where StreetWise ambassadors load their vehicles with boxes of food.
