

Credit Recovery Program Spring 2022

Credit recovery is a program for students who did not pass a class and earned a grade between 50%-69%. Students can take a condensed version of the course online to earn credit towards graduation. Successful credit recovery grades will appear on a student's transcript, but it will NOT replace the failed grade. Student athletes who are seeking athletic scholarships should consult with their counselor prior to registering for Credit Recovery because it is not accepted by the NCAA.

Who is eligible? Students who failed a class with a grade in the range of 50%-69%.

How much does credit recovery cost?

- A once per school year \$50 fee is payable on mypaymentsplus.com under the category "Events &
 Activities" tab and then under School Fees. Any additional credit recovery courses needed during
 the same school year will be free of charge.
- For students who do not successfully complete a credit recovery course and need to re-enroll in the same course, a \$25 re-enrollment fee will be charged PER COURSE. This fee can also be paid on mypaymentsplus.com.

When is the required Credit Recovery Boot Camp? Once a student is registered and enrolled, they must attend a mandatory Credit Recovery Boot Camp at MVHS. The January Credit Recovery Boot Camp will be Friday January 7 from 2:30-6:00, Saturday January 8 from 8:00 am - 4:00 pm, and Sunday January 9 from 1:00 pm-4:00 pm in the MVHS Media Center. The Boot camp will have certified teachers available to answer content related questions. Deadline to register is Wednesday, January 5, 2022.

What courses are offered?

- Math- Algebra 1, Geometry, Algebra 2, Pre-calculus
- Language Arts- 9th, 10th, 11th, and 12th
- Science- Biology, Chemistry, Anatomy, Astronomy, Environmental Science, Physics
- Social Studies- World Geography, World History, US History, Government, and Economics
- Health

End-of-course (EOC) Test Requirements: The following courses require an End-of-course (EOC) test that must be scheduled and taken in-person at MVHS once the online course work is completed: Algebra 1 (semester 2), Biology (semester 2), U.S. History (semester 2), & 11th grade American Literature (semester 2). These EOCs are worth 20% of the grade for the course.

How do I sign my student up for Credit Recovery?
