#### Call to Order:

### **Introductions**

All present members introduced themselves to our new Teacher of the Year Ms. Statesman. Mrs. Duckworth then shared the district **Building the Bridge** video with the council members.

#### **Minutes**

Mrs. Duckworth shared that we will review the minutes. She shared that this is our official first meeting. She shared a summary of the minutes inclusive of the School Council Bylaws. A copy of the finalized calendar for the 2023-2024 school year.

#### • 2023-2024 Calendar Review

Mrs. Duckworth shared information about the calendar.

#### Portrait of a Graduate

 Mrs. Duckworth shared a picture collage of the events that the school has held connected to the Portrait of a Graduate. She also shared that we still plan to bring the high school graduates back again at the end of this school year.



#### Enrollment Information

 Mrs. Duckworth shared that we are about 20 students below and therefore we had to lose 2 part time staff members. She shared the GCPS rule around who should be displaced and why. Mrs. Duckworth shared a table with information for the council inclusive of Program enrollment, Student attendance, student ethnicity.

## • Discipline Information

o Mr. Jackson shared the discipline information as of 9/10/23. He discussed that we have had 4 total incidents and explained the breakdown of these as it relates to In school suspension, Out of school suspension and administrative conferences. He shared that support from each staff member with SEL needs has helped tremendously.

# Gifted Updates

 Mrs. Jackson shared information about the Gifted program at Corley. She shared the current data, a video from CLT with the teachers practicing a Questioning strategy they can implement in their classrooms, and programming coming to Corley (National Junior Beta Club, Spelling Bee, and Saturday STEAM Academy).

#### Data Analysis

o Mr. Jackson shared the Georgia Milestones data by grade level. He shared the scatter plot graph of the data comparing Gwinnett County Public School, other Georgia Schools, and Gwinnett County Schools. He informed the council about our school being a pilot program with a new language arts program (EL) and our school still being able to perform high on the Milestones. He talked about the consistency of our practices at Corley being a huge reason for our success on this assessment. Mr. Jackson talked about the support that K-5 gets in relation to working with



teachers on the grade level teams. He shared the math data for the 3rd-5th grade team. We took a close look at the Science data and he highlighted our school as achieving high achievement in this subject area.

## Instructional Leadership Team

 Mrs. Duckworth shared that this year will be joined by the Executive Director of Leadership Dr. Walker. Mrs. Duckworth shared her new direction for the ILT and some of the training that will be available to the members.

# Blueprint for the Future

 Mrs. Duckworth shared the chart with the council and discussed how our LSPI are aligned to these areas.

# • LSPI Goals (Preview)

Mrs. Duckworth shared how each of our goals are attached to the Blueprint for the Future. She spoke on **Empathy 1.B**- Staff and Student Well Being, **Equity 2.A**- Multi-tiered System of Supports, and **Equity 2.B**-Opportunity and Access, **Effectiveness 3.A**- Results Based Evaluation System, **Excellence 4.A**- Preferred Education Destination, Family Engagement/ Building Capacity and the breakdown of which each of these categories and what falls under each category.
