Parents,

Your child participated in the PSAT in October and results have returned. Information regarding student scores are below:

What the PSAT 8/9 Measures:

The PSAT 8/9 measures the skills and knowledge appropriate for eighth and ninth grades. They work together to show college readiness over time so educators, students and parents can monitor student progress. The PSAT 8/9 content reflects the kind of meaningful, engaging and challenging work that students find in the best middle school and high school courses taught today. The PSAT 8/9 provides a clear, early picture of you and your readiness for college. Your scores help you and your teachers pinpoint areas for improvement.

The Readiness Test measures comprehension and reasoning skills, and focuses on close reading of passes in a wide array of subject areas. The Writing and Language Test measures a range of skills, including command of evidence, expression of ideas, and the use of Standard English conventions in grammar and punctuation. The Math Test covers a range of math practices, with an emphasis on problem solving, modeling, using tolls strategically and using algebraic structure.

How the PSAT is Scored?

Students receive a total score that is the sum of their scores on the two sections (Evidence-Based Reading and Writing and Math

How You Can Use the Student Score Report?

The student score report clearly summarizes a student's current achievement levels and encourages next steps for academic progress. Think of PSAT 8/9 score reports as roadmaps. They show what student's doing well, and what you should work on to get ready for the SAT—and for college. Students explained student scores during a recent Advisement lesson with their homeroom teachers.
