Accountability and flexibility are hallmarks of Gwinnett County Public Schools' success. Key to that success is ensuring that each school community understands the progress being made by its schools, as well as what plans will drive improvement. Each school creates a collaborative Local School Plan for Improvement (LSPI), with targeted goals based on student achievement results. These goals are dynamic, like our schools, and are updated to reflect changes that occur in schools. Data is used to determine areas needing improvement and to identify specific, measurable, annual objectives. Schools then determine how to use research-based strategies to achieve these goals, using flexibility as needed. The LSPI development process involves teachers, parents, and community members, so the entire school community has the opportunity to be involved in conversations about school improvement. Long Term Goal

By the year 2025-2026, Anderson-Livsey Elementary staff and students will increase performance in language arts including reading, writing and the application of these skills in science and social studies by increasing the percentage of students that perform in the proficient and/or distinguished levels on the Georgia Milestones Assessment to 70% or higher.

o Annual Goal

60% of students at Anderson-Livsey will demonstrate mastery of the reading AKS by scoring in the proficient or distinguished levels on the ELA GCPS District Assessments and ELA GMAS.

Long Term Goal

By the year 2025-2026, Anderson-Livsey Elementary staff and students will increase performance in mathematics by increasing the percentage of students that perform in the proficient and/or distinguished levels on the Georgia Milestones Assessment to 70% or higher.

o Annual Goal

60% of students at Anderson-Livsey will demonstrate mastery of the mathematics AKS by scoring in the proficient or distinguished levels on the Math GCPS District Assessments and Math GMAS.

· Long Term Goal

By 2025-2026, Anderson-Livsey Elementary staff will develop student scholars that demonstrate respect for others and personal accountability through a decrease in school-wide discipline infractions.

o Annual Goal

Anderson–Livsey students and staff will decrease the number of students receiving discipline referrals from 10% in 2018-2019 to less than 5% in the 2021-2022 school year.

o Annual Goal

Anderson-Livsey Elementary School's CCRPI score will be in the top 25% of Georgia elementary schools in 2021-22.

Long Term Goal

We will build our parents' capacity to support their children's academic achievement by implementing the activities identified in The Plan/The Promise.
