- Upon enrollment, families are encouraged to establish a MyPaymentsPlus account where they will review and acknowledge they have reviewed the plan and promise. This document will be revisited during the spring Parent-Teacher Conferences and periodically throughout the school year during scheduled parent-teacher-student conferences.
