How does the CDAT 9 schedule work?

CDAT 9 students are grouped together for 9th grade language arts, science, a technology elective*, and Longhorn Time. This unique schedule allows for more hand-on, experiential learning and cross-curricular projects.

*Students enrolled in CDAT 9 will be able to choose between *Introduction to Software Technology* and *Foundations of Engineering* at the start of the school year. Students who choose *Introduction to Software Technology* will have the opportunity to complete *AP Computer Science Principles* as an additional elective during their 9th grade year.
