Dual Enrollment at Georgia State

- Students are enrolled as Non-Degree seeking student type (no major is assigned)
- Students can take classes during the regular Fall, Spring, or Summer semesters using their **30 hour Dual Enrollment Funding**.
- Access to campus facilities, clubs & student life activities
 ~(Excluding Greek organizations)

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Cost

- Tuition is covered by Georgia Student Finance Commission (GFCS) up to the 30 hour cap
 - Courses must be selected from state approved list found on GA Futures
 - Non-funded classes must be paid for at the time of registration and paper work must be completed acknowledging responsibility of payment
 - **Once a student maxes out their 30 hour cap, students can self-pay and attend.**
- Mandatory university fees are waived
- Textbooks are provided on loan, but must be returned in good condition.
- Student Responsibilities:
 - Course specific fees: (Ex: science or foreign language)
 - Transportation
 - Parking and meals



Requirements & Considerations

- Must be a rising Junior or Senior in high school
- Must obtain approval from HS counselor & parent/guardian

- Atlanta: On campus (1000-4000 level courses), limited online courses available
- Perimeter: Online or on campus (1000-2000 courses)

- On track to graduate
- College Level Readiness:
 - Satisfactory test scores:
 - SAT 580ERW/560 Math
 - ACT 23 English/23 Math

Perimeter College

- 3.0 Core GPA
- On track to graduate
- College Level Readiness:
 - Satisfactory test scores:
 - SAT 530 ERW/530 Math
 - ACT 20 Eng/21 Math
 - Accuplacer (237 Reading, 4-8 Writeplacer, 258 QAS)

- November 1st
 - Application and Documentation deadline for SPRING 2022
- April 1st
 - Application and Documentation deadline for SUMMER 2022
- May 1st
 - Application and Documentation deadline for FALL 2022
