## **DUAL ENROLLMENT at Gwinnett Tech**

- Students in 10<sup>th</sup> grade can take technical (CTAE) courses
- Students in 11<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grade can take core, general education and technical courses
- 28 general education courses guaranteed to transfer to any USG college or university
- Classes offered online or on-campus at GTC
- Fall, Spring and Summer semesters
- Over 140 different programs of study





Test Score Requirements for Core Classes

#### SAT/PSAT-17 Reading, 17 Writing, 21 Math

#### <u>ACT-</u>14 English, 17 Math, 16 Reading

### <u>Cumulative GPA after 9<sup>th</sup> grade</u> – 2.6 or higher
