



PTSA Legislative Report September 2021

Georgia Legislative Session 2021 The 156th Georgia General Assembly convened 01/21/21 and adjourned sine die 3/31/21. 2021 is the first year of a two-year biennium, so bills that did not pass this session will be eligible next year. 1164 bills were introduced this session with 369 passed by the House and 355 passed by the Senate. Passed bills were sent to Gov Kemp to either sign or veto them.

Bills Pending Georgia Senate Education and Youth Committee:

SB 231: allow certain adults to enroll in charter schools that provide instruction only for individuals between ages 21 and 35 residing in this state who have not attained a high school diploma.

SR 136: to provide technical training to individual who have withdrawn from high school age 16 and older.

SB 110: Under the "Quality Basic Education Act", prohibit the assignment of graded homework for students in grades kindergarten through two.

SB 3: raise the age of mandatory education from 16 to 17.

Other Bills: SB 307, SB 288, SB 204, SB 17, SB 15.
