2023 BIRTH TO 5TH GRADE STEM EXHIBITION STUDENT GUIDE

1. DEFINE



2. EMPATHIZE

Next, talk to people facing the problem you want to solve. Try to imagine yourself in their situation and understand how they feel. Learn a lot about the issue by conducting an empathy interview, where you ask questions and listen carefully to their answers.

3. IDEATE



Be creative and think of as many ideas as possible to solve the problem. Choose an idea you think will work well, and create a step-by-step plan for bringing it to life. Think about the materials you will need to make it happen.

4. PROTOTYPE

Now, it's time to use the materials you gathered and follow your plan to build a prototype or model of your solution. Remember, It doesn't have to be perfect! The prototype is just something that represents your idea and helps you see how it works.

Ride Gwinnett's Newest Ride



Gwinnett Microtransit

Ride Gwinnett microtransit is an on-demand shared-ride service that you can order from your phone. All microtransit trips cost \$3 per trip and must begin and end within the microtransit zone. It's a convenient, flexible, and affordable way to get to more places.

How does it work?

- 1. Request your ride: Use the Ride Gwinnett app.
- 2. **Go to your pick-up location:** Your ride will arrive to you. Some locations like shopping plazas will have designated pick-up locations in the app.
- 3. Hop on board: Step into one of Ride Gwinnett's small shuttles or vans.
- 4. Pay your fare: Link your credit or debit card in the Ride Gwinnett app or use exact change.
- 5. Arrive to your destination: Go anywhere within the <u>Snellville zone</u> and <u>Lawrenceville zone</u>.

Ride Gwinnett microtransit also connects to our local fixed routes 40, 45, and 70 so you can travel beyond the microtransit zones.
