


BOOK FAIR IS HERE!





Ride Gwinnett microtransit is an on-demand shared-ride service that you can order from your phone. All microtransit trips cost \$3 per trip and must begin and end within the microtransit zone. It's a convenient, flexible, and affordable way to get to more places.

How does it work?

- 1. **Request your ride:** Use the Ride Gwinnett app.
- 2. **Go to your pick-up location:** Your ride will arrive to you. Some locations like shopping plazas will have designated pick-up locations in the app.
- 3. Hop on board: Step into one of Ride Gwinnett's small shuttles or vans.
- 4. Pay your fare: Link your credit or debit card in the Ride Gwinnett app or use exact change.
- 5. Arrive to your destination: Go anywhere within the Snellville zone and Lawrenceville zone.

Your ride doesn't have to stop there.

Ride Gwinnett microtransit also connects to our local fixed routes 40, 45, and 70 so you can travel beyond the microtransit zones.
